# GOING BACK - AND WAY BACK

## 1988

*The story behind the name of the OHS auditorium was seen in The Daily Star of May 7.*

*“The Oneonta High School Auditorium will be named after the former principal who was a leader of the school.*

*“Charles A. Belden, OHS principal from 1946 to 1973, will be honored during a ceremony...May 14, when the auditorium officially will be named after him.*

*“He’s a ‘gentle’ man,” said William Pirone, principal at the time. “Sensitive, insightful, flexible, understanding, bright, competent.”*

*Belden encouraged teachers and knew the strengths and weaknesses of his students, said Pirone. Belden was a well-respected role model and made students aware of the importance of an education, he said.*

*“One of the reasons I came back to Oneonta High School was to teach for Charles Belden,” said Pirone, who eventually stepped into the principal’s role at the school.*

*“I greatly admired him. There couldn’t be a tougher act to follow.”*

## 1960

*Readers of The Oneonta Star of Feb. 24 learned, “Oneonta Board of Education last night approved an evacuation program that would be carried out for Oneonta pupils in case of enemy attack.”*

*“The ‘Go-Home’ program, as it is known throughout the state, was outlined in detail by W.E. (Shorty) Long, director of health, physical education and safety for the Oneonta Consolidated School District.*

*“Harold V. Hager, school superintendent, said last night that Civil Defense officials told him that ‘even though Oneonta is not a number one target area, if sites as far away as Buffalo, Pittsburgh, New York City or the Air Base at Rome were hit, Oneonta children would be sent home.’*

*“Mr. Long said getting the city school pupils home will be no problem at all. The problem arises in connection with the ‘bus’ pupils. Estimated time to get the ‘bus’ pupils home is less than 1½ hours, Mr. Long said.”*

*“After an alert is sounded pupils will be quickly sent home from school. Parents will be informed to keep the pupils in their homes for at least one hour and a half.”*

*Fortunately, the program was never needed.*

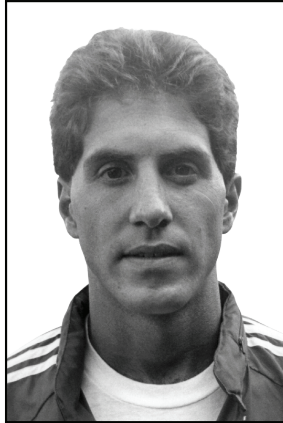

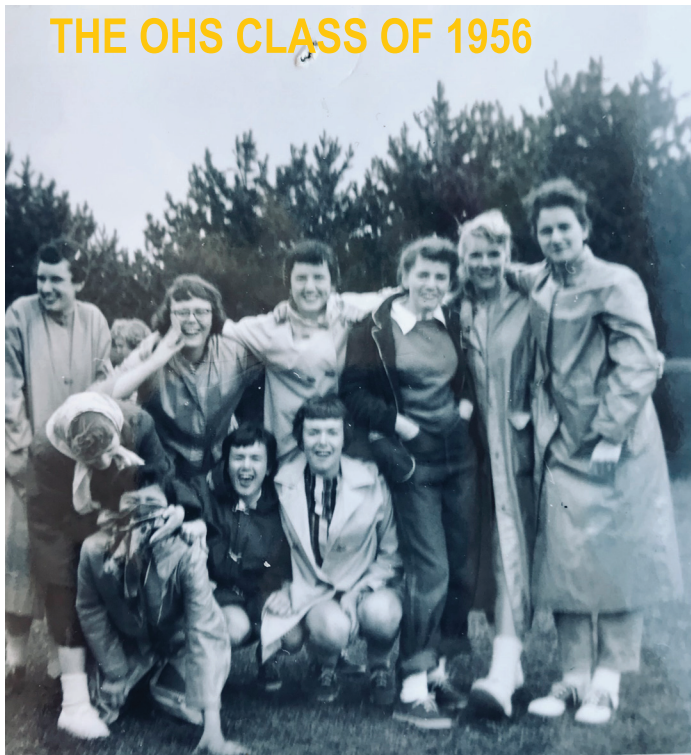
